Dear Friends in Christ,

This winter has been a brutal season. The extreme cold temperatures--which started in early December--to the endless snow. As I write this newsletter, I am wondering if winter will ever end. You are probably feeling the same way. The problem is that when things linger on--the way this weather is--we start to become hopeless and begin to doubt.

The real problem comes when we are dealing with serious issues in our lives. Whether it be chronic pain, on- going illnesses, financial issues, or struggling with a family member's infirmity, that feeling of hopelessness soon becomes real. Yes, we lift it up in prayer, but it seems as if God is not listening.

We can rest assured that, through the scriptures, we can and do know that God hears our prayers. It is because He has promised to hear them! Even if He doesn't always answer the way we think He should, He still hears us. The Psalmist declared, "As for me, I call to God ... and he hears my voice" (Psalm 55:16-17).

Why then, does God sometimes seem deaf to our prayers? One reason may be because we've allowed sin to take over and get in the way. We allow the noise of the world to wreak havoc in our hearts. Sin always cuts us off from God. Sometimes we just need to be still and know that He is God.

Often, however, God doesn't answer our prayers the way we think He should because He loves us, and He knows what is best for us. It's often been said that God answers prayer in one of three ways: "Yes", "No", and "Wait"—and it's true. We see only part of the picture—but God sees the whole picture. This is why we must seek God's will when we pray, and not just our own. The Bible says, "This is the confidence we have in approaching God: that if we ask anything according to his will ... we have what we asked of Him" (1 John 5:14-15). We see the type of prayer we need to pray just as Jesus did in the Garden on the night of His betrayal, "Not my will but thine."

Don't be discouraged. Instead, thank God for His love for you, and learn to commit everything to Him in prayer. The Bible says, "Rejoice always, pray continually" (1 Thessalonians 5:16-17). We are to remember that we are children of God and His promise is to never will end and summer is just around the
